For your information...

- We will keep the current **9am service** going into the autumn for the foreseeable future: as we have been doing in August, this service will be in church and 'livestreamed' on Microsoft Teams and via the website.
- The main (and exciting!) news is that alongside the 9am services, we will start a **new family friendly service** from September. The first of these services will be on **Sunday 6th September** at **11am**, and on this occasion only we are planning to have this service **outside** on the church lawn!
- The plan is that these 11am family friendly services will thereafter be in the hall so as not to clash with any deep cleaning that needs to be done in the main worship area after the 9am services.
- These family services will be around 30 minutes duration and we'll do our best to make them interactive, fun and with space to hear what God is saying to us!
- For the launch service on **6th September**, we're asking that people bring a rug to sit on (and chairs if you like!) and that you bring a picnic! **See the attached advert too!**
- We're hoping to have 'live' music as people arrive and 'settle in', and there will be time for dancing/signing/shaking an instrument for the praise of the Lord!
- This service is open to anyone....invite your neighbours/friends/family....and because it's outside there'll be no limit on numbers – again hallelujah!
- We will of course need to abide by the 'socially distanced' rule, so please make sure there is a 2m gap between you and other households!
- **Please pray**....this is really important...this will be a witness to the village that the church is alive and well, and much more importantly, that God is alive and well! And pray for good weather!!
