Who can be on the electoral roll?

To be on the electoral roll a person needs to have been baptised, be at least 16 years old and either:

For your information

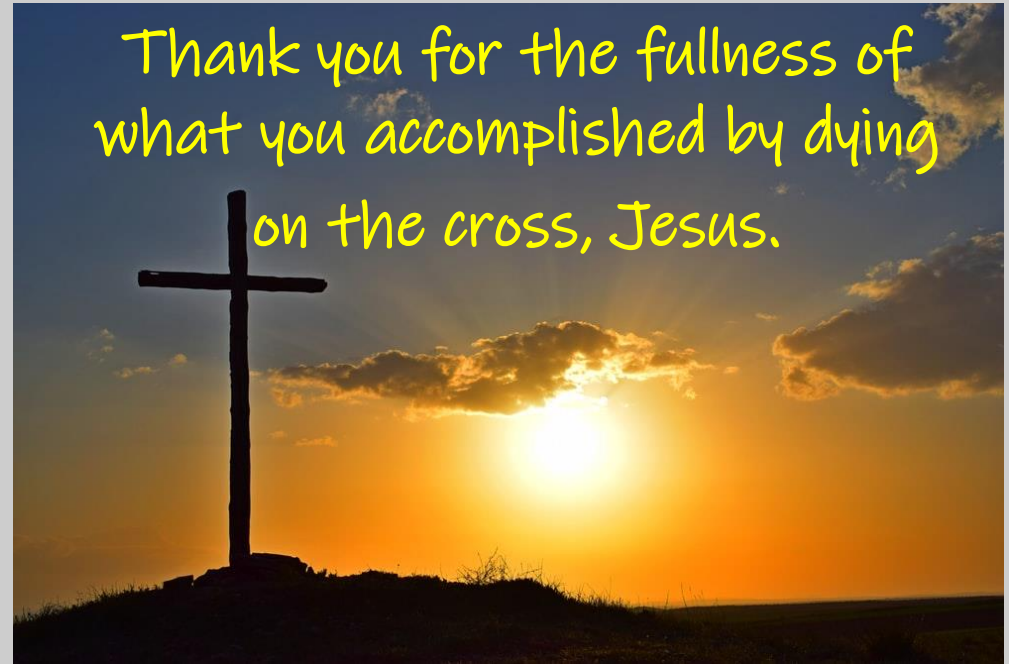
- a member of the Church of England or of a Church in communion with it and resident in the parish.
- a member of the Church of England or of a Church in communion with it, not resident in the parish, but habitually attended public worship in the parish during the preceding six months.
- a member in good standing of a Church not in communion with the Church of England but subscribes to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity and also a member of the Church of England and habitually attended public worship in the parish during the preceding six months.

If you think that you are not already on the roll, but would like to be, please collect a form from the foyer. The deadline is extended to Thursday 28th April.
