There are many Johns in the Bible. There's John the Baptist who used water to help others wash away all traces of their wrong doing. There's John who wrote Revelation foretelling of the end of all things, offering warnings to all - church goers and others alike. There's John - the one who Jesus loved during his time on earth. And there is John the Gospel writer accounting the story of that time in its own distinctive way.

Our 'John's Tale' is based on that unique piece of story telling.
